



Trainee PET Radiochemist

This is an exciting opportunity for a **Science Graduate** to work within the Radiochemistry Production team in London and to train in the manufacture of PET radiopharmaceuticals. The successful candidate will assist in the manufacture of radiopharmaceuticals at a GMP standard for clinical use.

Background

The Role

- Laboratory support for clinical studies.
- Keeping up to date with relevant procedures and policies.
- Monitoring and maintaining lab stocks of chemicals and consumables.
- Operating to approved quality standards by recording Production quality related actions (e.g. deviations, change controls,) in a timely manner, in order to comply with Invicro policies and regulatory requirements.
- Equipment maintenance, calibration of instruments, ordering and control of supplies for key equipment and/or provide assistance for these activities.
