



## Clinical Trials Physician

### The Role

The Clinical Trials Physician will support the design and conduct of imaging studies using PET, MRI and/or PET-MRI in healthy human volunteers and patients.

The main responsibilities of the role include:

- Management and governance for clinical studies and for specific study-related medical decisions and activities.
- Initiation of definitive strategies to anticipate and expertly manage medical safety issues, in partnership with the Chief Medical Officer including emergencies.
- Maintaining accurate records for conduct of clinical studies as required by ICH-GCP, and update relevant documentation associated with clinical activities within Imanova.
- Ensuring that investigational medicinal products are dispensed according to regulatory and GMP requirements.
- Ensuring all studies are conducted in compliance with the protocol, GCP, GMP, SOP's IRB/ethics committee and regulatory authorises.

### The Successful Candidate will have:

#### Essential:

- A Medical qualification allowing direct medical responsibility for human investigations in the UK.
- Good technical proficiency in the cannulation of peripheral veins and radial artery.
- Excellent communication skills and ability to develop and maintain good working relationships.
- The ability to work as an effective team member and demonstrate a proactive and adaptable approach.

#### Desirable:

- Appropriate post-registration experience.
- Experience in the conduct of clinical pharmacology studies.
- Appreciation of the scientific basis of study design, including pharmacokinetics, human toxicology, statistics and pharmacodynamics assessment.
- Knowledge of principles of PET and MRI molecular imaging.
